

SUGGESTIONS FOR A DOMESTIC ROTA

Domestic routines are a personal matter but our experience with Middle years groups has shown that this system works well.

1. Kitchen

Washing up: one sink for glasses, one for cutlery and one for crockery.

Drying up: one drier up for each sink. Put clean items ready for table setters.

2. Dining Room

Clearing and setting dining room tables: one per block of two tables. Clear jugs and condiments, wipe tables, sweep floor, set tables for next meal. On last day help to check and sort dining room cupboards.

3. Eco-Centre Duties

These may involve collecting and sorting waste for recycling / landfill / worms; reading gas, electricity and water meters; refilling bird feeders.
