Minibus travel.	All.	See advise prepared for minibus drivers.	
Walking along road to / from Camp.	All.	Group supervised by adult (s) depending upon size of group, walking on verge where possible. Vigilance by group leaders.	Single file - cross road by minibus not at Warham entrance.
Poisonous / Irritant items in hedgerows. (Bryony, Woody Nightshade, Holly, Privet)	Pickers / eaters.	Vigilance by group leaders. Hand washing after visit and before food.	Ensure group leaders aware of potential dangers.
Bulls /Cows.	All.	Ensure landowner / farmer is aware of visit to site well in advance. Keeping groups away from livestock. Vigilance by group leader of whereabouts of livestock.	
Steep banks.	All.	Warning given about banks, groups not permitted to run up / down banks. Use main access paths into the camp. First Aid kits carried.	
Stream.	All.	Banks well fenced. Vigilance by group leaders of barbed wire.	
Searching in Mole hills	All.	Gloves issued to those with cuts, sores etc. on hands. Hand washing after visit and before food.	
Stones	All	Do not permit throwing of loose stones

Walking from camp to Three Horseshoes	All	Inform of hazards (crossroads etc.) and advice precisely where to stand on pub carpark.
